On 11th December a 75 year old woman who was found abandoned on GST Road was picked up by our NSS volunteers and admitted into Little Drops. an NGO at Porur.

On 18th December Mr. Sathiyam, Field Officer of RRC gave a lecture on AIDS to create awareness among the students.

Mrs. Mangaiarkarasi our Programme officer was selected as a Committee Member and Master of Ceremonies at UNIFEST, a National Cultural Festival at SRM University from 3rd to 5th January 2007.

On 9th December NSS volunteers along with the Programme Officer, Mrs. Brammarambigai attended a meeting at Commissioner's Office regarding Red Flag Movement and received the certificates issued by Youth Task Force.

On 20th & 21st of December, six of our volunteers participated in a 2 day seminar held at Bharathi Women's College on Personality Development and Career Guidance.

The Special Camp at Serapanchery started on 2nd January 2007 and ended on 12th January 2007. This included programmes on AIDS awareness, pulse polio, competitions for the school children and the public and Free Medical Camp for the villagers.

On 3rd February our college made a contribution of Rs. 4400/- towards construction of building for inmates of Nethrodaya (an organization for the blind).

The camp started at Serapananchery on 02.01.2007 with an orientation speech to prepare the N.S.S. volunteers to adjust themselves to the new environment and successfully carry out the project.

On 03.01.2007 our Students made themselves familiar with the people of the village. They also did a census study about them. Students informed the village people about the various programmes and competitions which would be conducted during their stay. they consulted the head master of the school in which they were staying and fixed up the dates for the various literary and sports competitions to be held for the I to VIII students of the school.

On 04.01.2007 Mrs. Shamshul a resource person taught embroidery to the women self help group and 8th std. girls of the school. She also taught them bead work, mirror work and chamky work. On the same day our students conducted drawing competitions for I, II and III std. Students and Hand writing competitions for the students of IV and V. Recitation in Tamil was conducted for VI std. students. Mrs. Tamilselvi of Commerce Dept. of S.D.N.B. Vaishnav College was the judge for these competitions.

This year our college participated in the regional level competition held at Hotel Savera and competed with 20 reputed city colleges. The team has emerged as one among the four **regional winners** and was thus selected to attend the national level competition at Mumbai. At the national level the team competed with 3 other regional Winners from the southern region and 3 regional winners from the northern region. The team has obtained the **All India second position**. The projects undertaken by the team include Banana Fibre Promotion, Organic Tonic, Bhojana, Women Empowerment and Digital Banking. Here is a brief description of the major project - Banana Fibre Promotion.

Banana Fibre

The SIFE team identified a group of 30 to 40 weavers near the suburban area of Anakaputhur who have the special talent of using banana fibres in weaving saris, making bags, etc. Even with this extraordinary talent they were struggling hard for their livelihood because of lack of facilities. They did not have enough space and the necessary equipment for large scale production. They hardly complete 2 to 3 saris or materials a day.

Mr.C.Sekar, the head of this group of weavers has approached the government officials for support for the past four years. But this was in vain. The SIFE team thus decided to help these people to improve their business.

The SIFE team planned a function to promote and publicize these weavers and their products and invited poetess Ms. Kanimozhi, to be the special guest for the function. Ms. Kanimozhi offered to help the weavers and introduced them to a fabric designing and marketing firm named Srushti. Other dignitaries present at the function were Dr. Mrs.T.Sumitra, our college Principal, and Mrs. Bharathi Kumar, chairperson of Anakaputhur Municipality.

The programme was a success and the weavers received the attention of the government officials within a short span of time. The Joint director of handlooms visited the weavers and promised quick action.

The SIFE team met Mr. Pradeep Yadav, Kanchipuram District Collector to emphasize on the allocation of land for the weavers, We also met Mr. Vishwanath Shegaonkar, the Secretary of Handlooms requesting grant of equipments.

The SIFE team arranged a meeting between the weavers and the officials of the handlooms department. The officials have promised to arrange for a work shed for the weavers and land has been allocated near pump house in Anakaputhur. The MD of Co-optex has kindly consented to provide market support to the weavers.

These words of Niebuhr a theologian, which I read many decades ago, keeps ringing in my ears. When being in my teens and fired with youthful idealism, I thought it required only a little effort to change the world. Alas all too soon I released my folly!

But all the same, it is possible to bring about changes in minor things, such as resolving to get up early and being able to do so. An alarm clock will do the trick! one can try to advise young people and occasionally succeed in making them change for the better! (As a teacher on occasions I have seen marked improvement in students both in their performance and behaviour! So it is not a lost cause).

One can try advising others-one's peers and equals-but may not succeed always. On rare occasions it is possible. But once people are old and set in their ways it is difficult to make them change their ways. People find it hard, sometimes next to impossible, to accept the need for change. Only if and when one realises that one is in the wrong, does the need for change arise. We should also realise what are the things we can change and what can not be changed but has to be endured. We can change our friends if we realise they are not on the same wavelength or we could try to make them change their habits if we do not like their ways. But we should realise if it is possible to do so and if not, give up. But when it comes to relations, we cannot change them so we have to endure them.

God should give one the wisdom to be able to make this discerning judgement.
