## 1. AUTONOMOUS STRUCTURE

We have entered the III Year of autonomy. ## 4. ACADEMIC EXPANSION

Sixteen new staff members have joined our College in the regular stream with the permission from the University of Madras and the Joint Director of Collegiate education. Two new courses, M.A Human Resource Management and M.Sc. Physics have been introduced in this academic year. A third section in the B.Com and a second section in the B.C.A have been introduced in the self-financed stream.

An UGC Add on certificate programme (Television and Video presentation) under XI<sup>th</sup> plan of UGC will be conducted by the Dept. of Physics from the academic year 2009-2010 onwards. The Skill Based Certificate programmes, Retail Management, Logistics Management, Media and Journalistic Formatting and Apparel designing were inaugurated on 30<sup>th</sup> of August 2008. The dignitaries who graced the inauguration were Dr.Ranganatham, Registrar, University of Madras, Mr.Murugesan, Chairman, M.G.M Transport & Managing Partner of NSIT, Director of "Asatha Povathu Yaaru, Sun TV, Mr.T.Rajkumar and Mr.Sukumar, Principal, Tamilnadu Institute of Tailoring Technology.

The Skill Based Certificate programmes - Cosmetology, Travel and Tourism were inaugurated

on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2008 by Mrs.Manjula, Principal, Venus Beauty Parlor, Mr.S.Joseph, Professional Training Center and Consultancy and Mr.Balaji, Managing Director, IFX Software Solutions Pvt. Ltd.

Skill based certificate courses like Logistics Management, Retail management; Apparel Designing and Cosmetology were taught for II year students with lots of interactive sessions. All first year, both UG and PG students learnt Communicative English as skill based certificate programme and all the final year students of both UG & PG were taught "Employability Skills with Placement Aptitude".

## 5. ACADEMIC IN DEPTH PROGRAMME

The Department of English conducted a workshop on SOFT SKILLS on 17<sup>th</sup> October for Teachers and Professors from various schools and colleges in Chennai. Dr. Bharathi Harishankar, Reader in English, Madras University, Mrs. Sumathi, ICFAI University and Dr. S. Sridevi, Lecturer, CTTE College, conducted interesting sessions highlighting the need to be competent in English language.

A second one-day workshop on "Teaching of English" was organized on 18<sup>th</sup> February. Dr. V. Rajagopalan, Principal, SSKV Arts and Science College, Kanchipuram, inaugurated the workshop. Dr. V. Saraswathi, Grammar guru, Dr. Balu, and Mr. Kalyansundaram, Director, Excell Career India, Nungambakkam, brought out the significance of communication and soft skills with their inspiring and thought provoking lectures. Nearly 35 teachers and lecturers from various schools and colleges benefited from the workshop.

The Department of Mathematics organized a two day seminar on "Applied Mathematics" which was presided by Prof. V.Thangaraj, Ramanujan Institute for Advanced study in Mathematics and at present Controller of Examinations (in-charge), University of Madras. 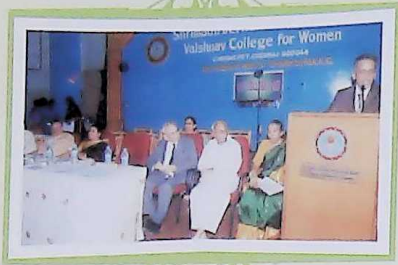

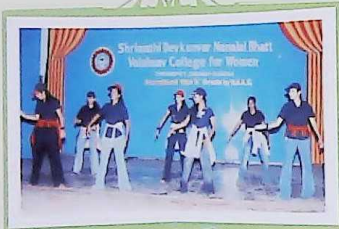

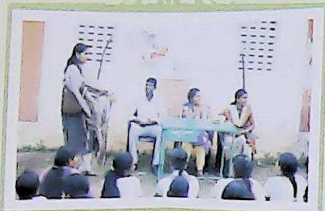

**Trade Winds:** Women folks exhibited willingness to learn and were determined to better their lives. Our approach to a hammock-making industrialist was favorable. They were looking for quality, skilled employees.

**Facilitated Training:** Seeking the Panchayat head's help, a social welfare hall served our purpose of training. Officials of INCA hammocks transferred skills over a month and even paid stipend.

**Smiles of Prosperity :** The company absorbed all trained women. We intervened to ensure that the raw materials were brought to their doorsteps and collected as finished products. An average income was between Rs.2500 to Rs.3000 per month. Besides the basic salary income was related to productivity.

**Channelising Prosperity:** The relatively new rich had to be taught saving and resource deployment. We educated the women folks by organizing an interactive session with bank officials.

**Win-Win Scenario :** The industry is happy, the family earnings have gone up, the cascade effect in the society is seen and the village Panchayat welcomes the visible

change. In all this, the SIFE members have played a pivotal role

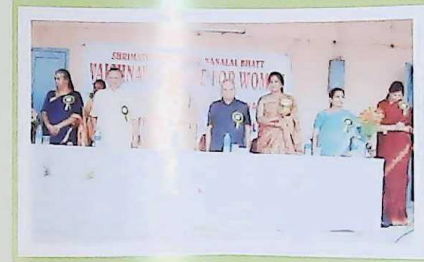

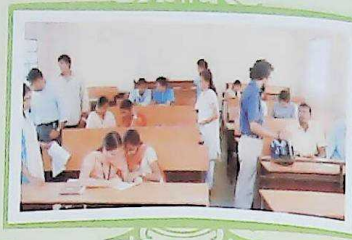

हरिणाक्षी अब्रवीत्-सदा भवतः स्वागतम्। तत्र कार्यागारे कर्तव्यं समाप्य हरिणाक्षीपितुः गृहं प्राप्तवान्। “स्वागतं भट्टवर्याय। आगम्यताम्। उपविष्यताम्” इति वदन् हरिणाक्ष्याः पिता स्वागतीकृत्य गणेशं मुखामने उपावेशयत्।

तदा हरिणाक्ष्याः माता आगत्य अवदत्-“अयि भो भट्टवर्या। अतिथिसत्कारं कर्तुम् इच्छामि। किन्तु भवन्त ब्राह्मणाः। वयं तु चतुर्वर्णीयाः भवन्तः स्वीकुर्वन्ति खलु?” इति। गणेशस्य शिरसि सहसा वज्राघात अभवत् इव। तस्य आशा भग्ना। ततः निरुत्साहं तं दृष्ट्वा माता अन्नपूर्णा किं कारणं तव उत्साहभङ्गस्य? इति सा अपृच्छत्।
